This plan calls for a shallow swale (@ 12" deep) to be dug in the center of the bed. Displaced soil would be used to form a low berm along the west side of the bed. The swale should be able to capture @ 1500 gallons of rainwater from the downspout. If the basin fills completely in a severe rainstorm, excess water will be directed to flow through a depression in the berm and into the existing overflow drain at the front of the bed. This plan does not call for the addition of an irrigation system.
